2022 Fraser Fresh Farmer's Market Full Season Policy

Registration

The City of Fraser must have application complete and approved by the Recreation Department for the Vendor to participate in the Fraser Fresh Farmers Market.

Products

The Parks and Recreation Department will coordinate and approve Growers/Artisans based upon items being sold. Pictures of items being sold must accompany your mailed in application. Our Farmer's Market (plant and food sales) must abide by State of Michigan food safety laws. If you are unfamiliar with these laws, please contact the Macomb County Health Department. No alcohol sales are permitted. Items requiring a food license must submit a copy of the current License along with application to be considered. You may only sell the items you place on your application, however if you need to add items you may contact us prior to the registration deadline and we can add them as long as it doesn't conflict with other vendors. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to deny an application if we deem it to be similar to another vendor. No direct marketing or "catalog" sales will be permitted. All products must be locally grown, locally baked or cooked, or hand made.

Set up/take down Set up will be between 8 am and 8:45 am please do not show up earlier. Vehicles will be allowed to drive onto the field to unload only unless weather prohibits. Only 10x10 tents are allowed. The 12x12 spaces are directly next to each other, so if you are planning to allow sales from the sides of your tent please plan accordingly within your 12x12 space. Canopy, chairs and tables are on your own. All tents **MUST** be anchored down. All Growers'/Artisans' must be set up and cars removed by **8:45 am. (No Exceptions for safety).** Please bring sufficient change for customers, bags are not required but appreciated. **Growers'/Artisans' spaces cannot be broken down prior to 1 pm unless all goods have been purchased.** No vehicles will be allowed onto the field until shoppers clear after 1 pm. All trash must be thrown away into the dumpster. (located by the fire bay)

Refunds

No Refunds will be given after April 24th for the current season. Refunds prior to April 24th will incur a \$5.00 processing fee. Refunds will be mailed to address listed on contact information.

Food Trucks

A maximum of 4 Food Trucks will be permitted on any one date. Food Trucks must commit to serve food unless given a 72-hour notice before canceling. Food trucks must have the appropriate licenses to make and serve food, and must be self-sufficient. Water hookup, electricity, or septic dump will not be provided.

Inclement Weather

The weather is one thing out of our control. If it is raining, bring your umbrella and stroll between the raindrops, the Market will be open! Our produce vendors work rain or shine and so do we. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to change the location setting at which point it would be first come first serve.

- For the threat of lightning, people in the Market will be directed to their vehicles by Market Volunteers until 30 minutes have passed lightning/thunder free.
- If more than 60 minutes have passed and the storm continues or the Market Organizer can verify an extended storm cell's presence exceeding the remaining open hours of the Market, the Market will be closed for the day.
